

CCOO'S PRIORITY IS TO END THE HEALTH CRISIS WHILE PROMOTING A SOCIAL AND ECONOMIC RECOVERY PLAN THAT RECOVERS EMPLOYMENT

The Coronavirus is a major global health crisis and, at the same time has and will have very serious economic and social consequences.

Spain is suffering particularly from the seriousness of the pandemic in terms of health, but also from its enormous impact on workers. CCOO, as the most representative trade union in the country and the largest socio-political organization, is at the service of the Government and the other public institutions to help overcome this crisis.

We share the need to give absolute priority to emergency health care. Thus, the entire Spanish health system must be made available to the general interest and to the public authorities. At this point, we want to transfer our greatest support to the health workers, as well as to other professionals who, from different fields, continue with their activity for the good of the rest of society, without having guaranteed, in all cases, the safety for their health.

But the drastic measures that are being taken will have a devastating effect in the short term, which is multiplying the dismissals and the Temporary Employment Regulation (TER) due to the suspension of the activity. To mitigate these effects, sufficient resources are needed to protect people affected by TER and to deal with social emergency situations of those who have to reconcile family care with work, as well as measures to stop job destruction and plans for economic recovery and boosting that will prevent the crisis and its social consequences from being prolonged. A social shock plan is needed to help those who suffer most from the consequences of the crisis.
