## Finalizing the joint project with the conference

As part of their integrated projects 2020-2021, the European Social Partners are conducting a project looking into the impact of the circular economy transition on employment, labour markets and working conditions. Three national joint cluster seminars have been organised where national Social Partners exchanged good practices and views on this topic.

Our selected contractor Trinomics, has gathered the results of these seminars in a final report, which will be presented at the conference. This final report also includes the main results of a series of interviews and an online survey with national/sectoral employer and trade union member federations and companies (management and worker representatives) on how the circular economy transition impacts their national labour market and on working conditions, including occupational health and safety.

Furthermore, the European Social Partners are currently negotiating policy recommendations both for Social Partners as well as for policy-makers, which we aim to present at the final conference.

Finally, we expect several high-level decision-makers from the European institutions and representatives from national and sectoral social partners to join the panels and to discuss how to tackle the socio-economic dimension of the shift to circular economy.

# **Practical organisation**

This conference will take place in a hybrid from. The ETUC auditorium will be transformed into a TV studio and with a bit of luck we will even be able to welcome a limited number of participants









physically. At the same time, we offer everyone the possibility to join this conference remotely, given the changing nature of sanitary measures and potential travel restrictions.

The number of participants will be equally distributed between the trade union and the employers side. A final decision on how many persons will be allowed to join the event physically will be taken at a later stage, based on an evaluation of the pandemic situation, the sanitary measures and travel possibilities.


